1. In the absence of Dan Clay, Vice President Roy Leckonby called the meeting to order at 9:12AM
2. Roy Leckonby established that a visual quorum of CAG members was in attendance
3. Minutes from the 3/21/02 Special Meeting were reviewed. Motion to accept the minutes as submitted was made by John Ondick; second by Tom Roberts. Motion approved.
4. Jonathan Fleming showed preliminary work done on the web site
 - a) Jonathan indicated that he is not pleased with some of the look and feel of what has been done so far.
 - b) Jonathan requested that each CAG member create a very brief bio that would be included on the web site.

 - b) New wells are going very slowly. One casing is set with the second started 4/19/02. All work will be completed during the first week of May. Well location is approximately 25 feet east of the benzene hot spot. Sampling should take place approximately mid-May.
